

## NC GENERAL CONTRACTOR LICENSE LAW CHANGES

All General Contractors are now

## **REQUIRED**

to include their North Carolina General Contractor License Number on Everything!

The new regulation, 21 NCAC 12.0501, states: "license numbers shall be included on all contracts, advertisements, and licensee websites."

General Contractors are advised to begin putting their GC License Number on:

- Contracts
- Subcontracts
- Business cards
- Project signs
- Signs on vehicles
- Website
- Advertisements
- Email signature blocks
- Letterhead & stationery

The North Carolina Licensing Board for General Contractors will likely be taking a lenient approach to stationery and business cards until you run out of stock.

The new regulation is part of a larger re-write of the NC GC Licensing Board Regulations in Title 21, Chapter 12 of the NC Administrative Code.
